## TAX BILLS WILL BE MAILED ON JUNE 30, 2020

Notice is hereby given to the taxpayers of the town of Killingworth, that the first installment of Real Estate and Personal Property taxes on the Grand List of October 1, 2019, is due and payable on July 1, 2020. Motor Vehicle taxes are also due on July 1, 2020, in one installment.

If not paid on or before August 3, 2020 the installment becomes delinquent and subject to interest. In accordance with Executive order 7S the interest will accrue at a rate of 3% per annum (0.25% for each month or fraction thereof) dating back to the original due date of the bill for a period of 3 months. After the three month period has expired, the interest will revert back to a rate of 18% per annum (1.5% for each month or fraction thereof).

You may pay by mail. Please return payment coupon(s) with your payment. Checks should be made payable to: Tax Collector. Mailing address is: 323 Route 81, Killingworth, CT 06419. Mail postmarked on or before August 3, 2020 will be considered an on time payment. (US Postal Service postmark only) If you would like a receipt returned to you, please include a self-addressed stamped envelope. As a matter of law, the taxpayer is liable to the town for the tax installment(s) as they become due and payable. Liability is not created by, nor dependent upon receipt of a tax bill. Therefore, failure to receive a bill does not relieve the taxpayer of the requirement to pay the statutorily required interest when a late payment is made.
